ACCEPTABLE RECYCABLE ITEMS

- ➔ Paper / Newspapers - daily, Sunday papers, Shoppers, magazines, office paper, paperback books & phonebooks, etc.
- ➔ Corrugated Cardboard & paperboard boxes & cardboard materials - boxes must be collapsed or broken down
- ➔ Metals - Aluminum, Steel, Tin - cans, pie tins, cake pans or steel food, soup or beverage cans
- ➔ Glass bottles or jars, clear, brown, blue or green
- ➔ Plastics #'s 1 through 6 - milk jugs, beverage & laundry detergent containers, ice cream pails, butter tubs, etc.

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS

NO Window pane, auto or kitchenware, pyrex glass
NO Styrofoam or packaging
NO Batteries
NO Garbage
NO Light bulbs
NO Yard waste, grass, leaves or plants
NO TV's
NO Appliances
NO Tissue paper or paper towels
NO Furniture, tables, chairs, lamps, etc.

NO Clay pots, dishes or ceramics
NO Plastic toys
NO Demolition debris, concrete, sheetrock, or wood etc.
NO Hazardous waste
NO Paint, latex, oil or ANY liquids
NO Tires, rims or auto parts
NO Electronics, toasters, coffee pots, VCRs, phones etc.
NO Textiles, clothes or shoes
NO gift wrap or food plastic wrap
NO Mattress or box springs

NOTHING other than the acceptable items listed above
